

## Wascana Freewheelers Bicycle Touring Club, Inc Self-Supported and Multi-Day Tour Guidelines

1. The Wascana Freewheelers Bicycle Touring Club offers self supported and multi-day tours on the understanding that they are "Common Adventures" where participants conduct themselves independently, make their own judgments about safety and well being, take full responsibility for their own actions, and contribute whatever they can towards the success of the trip.

2. The Tour Coordinator is not a leader or professional guide of any type and act only to provide suggested logistical arrangements for initiating and running the trip.

- 3. Participants must be members of the Wascana Freewheelers and at least 19 years or age or accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- 4. Participants are expected to possess any skills, equipment, fitness, common sense, etiquette, knowledge of applicable legislations, etc., to enjoyably and safely be involved in this activity.
- 5. Participants are the sole and final judges about their capability to safely proceed with any tour.
- Participants will wear at all times while operating a bicycle on a Wascana Freewheelers' sanctioned tour, a bicycle helmet, properly fastened, approved byANSI, SNELL, or CSA, and will ride courteously and abide by all applicable legislations.
- 7. Participants are responsible for paying all their own expenses "as they go" around the route. This includes transportation to/from the tour area, all food, trail and accommodation fees.
- 8. Any common expenses, such as van rental will be divided among participants.
