What a great year it was. The average number of riders on Wednesday nights was 14. Only one minor incident was noted during one Wednesday ride when a rider fell into tall grass resulting in minor abrasion to the cyclist's leg. The end of the month rides that were held in the north end of the city saw the lowest participation with an average of 8 cyclists per ride.

In some cases, ride leaders chose to lead their group without a second ride leader. This was appreciated by some members as it provided opportunities for socialising among all riders. No incidents resulted from this situation, but occasionally drivers stuck behind the group, showed signs of frustration trying to pass. Also some members felt that the pace was too fast and could not follow the leading group. Is there a need for 2 groups and if so, how can it be positively reinforced?

Wascana Freewheelers (WFW) should try to take an environmentally friendly turn. Ride leader packages contain excessive amounts of paper and plastic that are usually not used/recycled. A weekly package could be made available and passed from leader to leader or handed to the ride coordinator at the end of each ride. Only the package attendance sheet would be replaced weekly. Some options for distributing Wednesday night ride documentation could be: posting on the WFW web site or email of documentation upon request.
